

Pickleball Team League

RULES

Scheduled Match Time: The match is set to commence at 6:00 PM; however, the start time may vary by 5 minutes depending on court assignment/availability.

General Guidelines

Captains are responsible for ensuring their teams arrive promptly for scheduled matches. Any delay exceeding 10 minutes will result in the opposing team being awarded a 3-point lead. Each team is allowed 5 minutes of warmup time on the court before play begins.

Pre-Match Procedures

Captains must determine, through an impartial method such as a coin flip or paddle handle positioning, which team will serve, receive, or select the court end. Team lineups should be prepared in advance and ready for presentation.

Game Schedule, Scoring Format & Tiebreakers

Matches are played to 11 points, with a team needing to win by 2 points. If the total score is tied at the conclusion of all 12 games, a new game of mixed doubles will be played to 11 points. The winner of this tiebreaker earns 3 points, while the runner-up receives zero.

Timeouts and Coaching

Each team is permitted one player timeout of one minute per game, along with a single 15-second coaching timeout per game.

Substitutions

Each team captain may make one substitution per game, with a substitution period limited to 15 seconds.
